

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR SUMMER CAMP

Appropriate Soccer Attire: Players are required to come dressed in appropriate soccer attire, (shorts and t-shirts are highly suggested - light colors are preferred). Additionally, players should use appropriate footwear. Regular sneakers are acceptable; however, cleats for outdoor time are highly suggested. If cleats are being used, players would need to change to indoor soccer shoes or regular sneakers for inside activities or when transitioning between indoor and outdoor spaces. Shin guards are required as players will engage in scrimmage time.

This rule ensures that players are properly equipped for both indoor and outdoor activities during the camp, promoting safety and preparedness for all training sessions and games.

Code of Conduct: Participants are expected to adhere to a code of conduct that promotes good sportsmanship, respect for coaches, fellow players, and officials, as well as fair play.

- 1. **Age and Skill Level**: Players will be separated by age and/or skill level to ensure that participants are appropriately grouped for training sessions and activities.
- 2. **Safety Guidelines**: Safety is paramount, so rules regarding appropriate equipment, such as shin guards, and conduct during drills and games to prevent injuries are enforced.
- 3. **Attendance and Punctuality**: Participants are expected to attend all scheduled sessions on time. Refunds will not be provided for players who are absent or have arrived late.
